

Statutory Instrument 22 of 1997.

Animal Health (Import) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997 (No. 4)

IT is hereby notified that the Minister of Agriculture has, in terms of section 5 of the Animal Health Act [*Chapter 19:01*], made the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Animal Health (Import) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997 (No. 4).

2. The First Schedule to the Animal Health (Import) Regulations, 1989, published in Statutory Instrument 57 of 1989 (hereinafter called “the principal regulations”), is amended—

(a) in item 9, by the insertion after “in captivity” of “including ostriches”;

(b) by the insertion of the following item—

“13. Bees”.

3. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is amended—

(a) in Part I—

(i) by the repeal of item 6 and the substitution of—

“6. Hides and skins of animals, excluding wet blue processed hides and skins;

(ii) by the insertion of the following item—

“12. Honey, bees wax, hives, brood chambers, combs, or any bee keeping equipment”;

(b) in Part II by the insertion of the following item—

“3. Crates or boxes to house animals or animal products”.
