Parks and Wild Life (Payment for Hunting of Animals and Fish)  
Notice, 1987

THE Minister of Natural Resources and Tourism, in terms of subsection (2) of section 91 of the Parks and Wild Life Act, 1975, hereby makes the following notice:—

1. This notice may be cited as the Parks and Wild Life (Payment for Hunting of Animals and Fish) Notice, 1987.

2. The amounts specified in the second column shall, in respect of the species of animals and fish specified in the first column of the Schedule, be imposed in terms of an order made in terms of subsection (1) of section 91 of the Act.

3. The Parks and Wild Life (Payment for Hunting of Animals and Fish) Notice, 1982, published in Statutory Instrument 647 of 1982, and the Parks and Wild Life (Payment for Hunting of Animals and Fish) (Amendment) Notice, 1984 (No. 1), published in Statutory Instrument 109 of 1984, are repealed.
