

**ANIMAL DISEASES (PROHIBITION OF
IMPORTATION) ORDER**

O. 28/1956

made under sections 2 and 13

1. This Order may be cited as the Animal Diseases (Prohibition of Citation.
Importation) Order.

2. In this Order— Interpretation.
“fodder” means fodder of any kind brought with any animal;
“litter” means any straw, hay and any other substance used as
bedding for any animal and includes excreta of such animal.

3. The definition of the expression “animal” in section 2 of the Definition
Animals Diseases Act, is hereby extended for the purposes of this “animal”.
Order to include cats and mongooses.

4. On and after the publication of this Order in the *Gazette*, Importation
animals or the carcasses thereof, or any fodder or litter thereof shall from
not be brought from Grenada into Guyana. Grenada.
