- 1. This Order may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Pro- Citation. hibition of Importation) Order and shall come into operation on 2nd August, 1954.
 - 2. In this Order-

Interpretation

- "cloven footed animal" means any bull, cow, ox, heifer, calf, sheep, swine, goat or deer;
- "other animals" means horses, mares, geldings, colts, fillies, mules, asses, dogs and wild animals;
- "fodder" means fodder of any kind brought with cloven footed animals or other animals;
- "footwear" means wearing apparel for the feet, and includes boots, shoes, slippers and sandals.
- 3. Cloven footed animals and meats and their meat products Bringing of whether fresh, frozen, chilled or dried, fittings, utensils, pens, crates and other animal containers, hides, skins, horns, hair, wool, dehyd-Guyana. rated or fresh blood, bones and bonemeal, tankage, hoofs, fodder, straw for forage or packing, milk and other dairy products, and manure and other animal wastes shall not be brought from any of the territories set out in the Schedule into Guyana.

4. Other animals shall not be imported into Guyana from any of Bringing of the territories set out in the Schedule except under an import licence other animals. issued by the Minister.

5. The discharge of sweepings, garbage or other waste material Discharge of into Guyana or its territe l waters from vessels or aircraft arriving sweepings. from any of the territories set out in the Schedule is hereby prohibited.
