

**ANIMALS DISEASES (CONDITIONS OF
IMPORTATION) OF BIRDS ORDER**

O. 9/1958

made under sections 2 and 13

1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Conditions of Importation of Birds) Order. Citation.

2. In this Order—

Interpretation.

“poultry” means any live bird of the following species, that is to say, any domestic fowl, turkey, goose, duck, guinea fowl, pheasant or pigeon;

“birds” means live birds other than poultry.

3. For the purposes of this Order, birds shall be included in the expression “animal” in section 2 of the Act. Birds.

4. Birds imported into Guyana must be accompanied by a certificate of health signed by the proper authority in the country of origin: Birds to be accompanied by certificate.

Provided that birds may only be imported from those States of the United States of America that are certified as aforesaid as being free from psittacosis.
