Interpretation.

made under sections 2 and 13

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Animals Diseases (Conditions Citation. of Importation of Birds) Order.
- 2. In this Order—
 "poultry" means any live bird of the following species, that is to say, any domestic fowl, turkey, goose, duck, guinea fowl, pheasant or pigeon;

"birds" means live birds other than poultry,

- 3. For the purposes of this Order, birds shall be included in the Birds. expression "animal" in section 2 of the Act.
- 4. Birds imported into Guyana must be accompanied by a Birds to be certificate of health signed by the proper authority in the country of accompanied by certificate. origin:

Provided that birds may only be imported from those States of the United States of America that are certified as aforesaid as being free from psittacosis.
