An Act to amend the Zambia Police Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Zambia.

26th September, 2008

1. This Act may be cited as the Zambia Police (Amendment) Act, 2008, and shall be read as one with the Zambia Police Act, in this Act referred to as the principal Act.

2. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section fifty-seven F and the substitution therefor of the following section:

57F. The members of the Authority shall be paid such allowances as the Minister may determine.

3. The principal Act is amended by the repeal of section fifty-seven G and the substitution therefor of the following new section:

57G. The functions of the Authority are to—

(a) receive all complaints against police actions; (b) investigate all complaints against police actions which result in serious injury or the

death of a person;

(c) submit its findings and recommendations to—

(i) the Permanent Secretary to the Ministry responsible for home affairs:

(ii) the Police and Prisons Service Commission:

(iii) the Inspector-General;

(iv) any other relevant body or authority as the circumstances of the case may require.

- **4.** Section *fifty-seven H* of the principal Act is amended in subsection (2)—
 - (a) by the deletion of the word "and" at the end of paragraph(b);
 - (b) by the deletion of the full stop at the end of paragraph (c) and the substitution therefor of a semi-colon;
 - (c) by the insertion after the colon at the end of paragraph (c) of the word "and"; and
 - (d) by the insertion after paragraph (c) of the following new paragraph:
 - (d) recommend to the Police and Prisons Service Commission the punishment of any police officer found by the Authority to have erred in the performance of their duties or to have used excessive power against any person:

Provided that the punishment to be meted out against an erring officer shall be determined by the Police and Prisons Service Commission in accordance with the Police and Prisons Service Commission Regulations.
