# The Animal Health (Veterinary Services Fees) Regulations, 2018

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section 80 of the Animal Health Act, 2010 the following Regulations are made:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Animal Health Title (Veterinary Services Fees) Regulations, 2018.
- 2. The fees set out in the Schedule are applicable fees for the Fees matters specified in that Schedule.
- 3. The Animal Health (Veterinary Services Fees) Regulations, 2016, are revoked.
