The Plant Varieties and Seeds Act (Laws, Volume 14, Cap. 236)

The Plant Varieties and Seeds (Amendment) Regulations, 1997

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections thirty-five and eighty-four of the Plant Varieties and Seeds Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Plant Varieties and Seeds (Amendment) Regulations, 1997, and shall be read as one with the Plant Varieties and Seeds Regulations, in these Regulations referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. The principal Regulations are amended by the revocation of the Sixth Schedule and the substitution therefor of the Sixth Schedule set out in the Appendix to these Regulations.
