**The National Parks and Wildlife (Night Game Drives)
Regulations, 1997**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in sections *fifty-three, sixty-two and one hundred and eighty-five* of the National Parks and Wildlife Act, the following Regulations are made:

| 1. These regulations may be cited as the National Parks and Wildlife (Night Game Drives) Regulations, 1997. | Title |
| 2. Any tourist operator wishing to conduct a night game drive for the purpose of game viewing shall apply to the Director in writing. | Night game drives |
| 3. Any tourist operator based inside a national park shall pay a fee of <i>twenty</i> United States Dollars per vehicle per month for the purpose of night drives. | Operators inside national parks |
| 4. Any tourist operator based outside a national park shall pay a fee of <i>twenty</i> United States Dollars per vehicle per day for the purpose of night game drive. | Operators outside parks |
| 5. It shall be an offence for any tourist operator to conduct night game drives without written authorisation from the Director. | Offence |
