1. Citation

This Order may be cited as Pounds (Variation of Fees for Certain Townships) Order.

2. Variation of tariff

The tariff of fees and rates fixed in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Schedules to the Pounds Act are hereby altered as specified in the Schedules to this Order in respect of pounds, within the following townships and city, namely-

- (a) Francistown Township;
- (b) Gaborone city;
- (c) Lobatse Township;
- (d) Selebi-Phikwe Township;
- (e) Jwaneng Township.
