1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the Tsetse Fly Control Order.

2. Directions

All persons travelling on the following roads shall, if so required by an administrative officer, pass through the de-flying chambers specified below together with their vehicles, donkeys, horses or other draught animals:

Sankuyu to Maun Road	De-flying chamber north of Shorobe.
Sehitwa to Shakawe Road	De-flying chamber south and north of Tsau, south and north of Nokaneng and Gomare.
Xai-Xai to Tsau Road	De-flying chamber north of Tsau.
Xangwa to Nokaneng Road	De-flying chamber north of Nokaneng.
Kachikau to Kasane Road	De-flying chamber at Kachikau and Ngoma.

3. Cattle race

All cattle other than draught animals if so required by an administrative officer shall pass through the cattle races adjacent to the de-flying chambers specified in paragraph 2.

4. Pickets

All persons on the road specified in paragraph 2 shall, if so required by an administrative officer pass through such temporary pickets as may from time to time be erected for the purposes of tsetse fly control.
